Subject contents	<p>Grammar material: proximal and distal complement pronouns; imperative mode; simple past perfect tense (PPS); past imperfect tense (Pretérito Imperfeito), pretérito mais-que-perfeito, infinitivo pessoal. Vocabulary material: numerals up to 1000; parts of the body; visiting the doctor; physical description of people; parts of clothing and others.</p>		

Prerequisites and co-requisites	<p>It is required to pass the course in the first semester of Portuguese language study (4th semester of study). Absence from a test announced in advance by the class instructor can only be excused by a medical exemption. The test must be written immediately after the end of the leave and the student's return to class. Failure to write the test will result in a failing grade. Each test may be re-sit only once. Failure to pass one of the mid-semester tests will result in a failing grade at the end of the semester. Failure to complete homework twice and/or failure to check the vocabulary (in sources indicated by the tutor) in the assigned exercises/ texts will result in a failing grade. This grade may be corrected after completing an additional assignment assigned by the teacher and receiving a passing grade on it. The teacher may fail a student whose absenteeism exceeds 40%. In the case of two teachers - a student passes the course after obtaining a positive mark from each of the instructors, and the final mark is the arithmetic mean.</p>
