Prerequisites and co-requisites	<p>Credit for the course is required in the second semester of Portuguese language study (5th semester of studies).</p> <p>Absence from a test announced in advance by the instructor can only be excused by a medical exemption. The test must be written immediately after the end of the leave and the student's return to class (failure to write the test will result in a failing grade). Each test may be re-sit only once. Failure to pass the tests/ midterm papers will result in non-admission to the examination.</p> <p>Missing homework twice and/or failing to check the vocabulary (in sources indicated by the instructor) in the assigned exercises/texts will result in a failing grade. This mark may be corrected after the completion of an additional assignment assigned by the teacher and receiving a pass mark from it.</p> <p>The examination consists of a written and an oral part. Passing the examination means passing both the written and the oral part.1. written part (test from the content of the curriculum) - 70% of the final examination grade. The written part consists of a grammar part and a lexical part. A prerequisite for passing the written part is passing both its parts (obtaining at least 51% of each)2. oral part: an answer to one drawn question (in accordance with the course contents) and/or a statement prepared by the student before the examination (the topic to be developed as agreed with the teacher during the last semester of study (30% of the final mark in the examination).Failure in one part of the written examination (grammar or lexis part) results in an improvement of the whole written examination.Candidates who have passed the written examination will be admitted to the oral examination.Failure in the oral examination will result in an improvement in that part of the examination only.In the case of two instructors, the examination is prepared jointly by both teachers and constitutes an integral whole.The teacher may not allow a student whose absenteeism from classes exceeds 40% to take an examination.</p>
