Subject objectives	The purpose of the course is to familiarize students with selected legal regulations in the field of social assistance law and social insurance law. Attention will also be paid to parental rights, including those related to the implementation of EU directives. Moreover, the objective of the course is to acquaint students with practical aspects of selected family and guardianship law institutions within the current codifications and extra-codex sources, using the relevant doctrine and judicature. The exercises are also aimed at preparing students to apply the indicated regulations in practice and developing appropriate social competencies, and serving as an auxiliary form of education to the lecture, helping the student prepare for the exam in the subject.
