Subject contents	<p>Lecture topics: Relationships of contemporary Polish literature with earlier literary eras, including this era in the long history of Polish literature. Exposition of basic literary trends present in Polish literature 1939-1989. Discussion of the works of the most important authors of the era, as well as an introduction to the biographies of key poets, prose writers and playwrights. Presentation of literature research methods from 1939-1989, taking into account the latest forms of problematization of works of this period. Supplementing knowledge about contemporary Polish literature 1939-1989 with the appropriate European and world context; presenting the subject issues in a broader perspective of the evolution of European and world literature.</p>		
Prerequisites and co-requisites	<p>Completion of the course "Contemporary Literature 1939-1989 - exercises - poetry" in semester 5 Basic knowledge of poetics with particular emphasis on genology (unless the instructor decides otherwise in special cases).
