Subject objectives	<p>The aim of the course is to familiarise students with the methodologies that make up Arts Based Research (ArtsBased Research) and PaR (Practice as Research) type research. Within the framework of the proposed series, they will learn the specificities and planning strategies of Arts Based Research and PaR research and acquire the skills to use the research methods available in this field. During the course, students will acquire the skills to understand and interpreting the results of art-based research, as well as the practical use of art discipline-specific research methods.</p> <p>The course enables students to use modes of practice as the primary research method. The practical work can take several forms, including (but not limited to) live performance, performance installation, site-specific performance, video work, multi-media work, the writing of a play, curatorial work (including recording what has happened in the past or organizing an exhibition), historical performance reconstruction, space and/or costume design, organizing and running participatory workshops, and video documentaries.</p>
