Subject contents	<p>1. Integrated Kashubian language course (30 h) - aimed at comprehensive development of receptive (listening and reading) and productive (speaking and writing) skills, including grammatical issues appropriate to the level and developing lexical resources. Thematic areas: mass media (press, radio, Internet, television), new technologies, culture, films, music, current social, cultural and political problems, reading journalistic texts, awareness, generations, Kashubian customs (extension).</p> <p>2. Writing (30 h): writing down texts by ear; working with texts written in other alphabets; proofreading texts; creating written statements of a popular science and journalistic nature.</p> <p>3. Lexicon and conversations (30 h): enriching vocabulary (in the thematic areas presented in point 1) and using it during conversations; participation in talks moderated by the lecturer (adapted to the students' linguistic competence).</p> <p>4. Kashubian language for academic purposes (30 h): analysis of linguistic, stylistic and genre standards applicable in scientific texts; determinants of scientific style; writing of scientific works; standards for creating footnotes and bibliographies in works.</p>								
Prerequisites and co-requisites	<p>Due to the need to properly implement the study plan and educational program, the student should first receive a pass in the subject: practical learning of the Kashubian language IV (PNJK IV). In special cases, the teacher may decide otherwise.</p> <p>Passing the "Kashubian language for academic purposes" component (necessary to take the exam) is based on practical work agreed with the teacher (80%) and participation in classes (20%); passing the remaining components as in the subject card: practical learning of the Kashubian language III (PNJK III).</p>
