| Example issues/ example questions/ tasks being completed | <p>In small groups, participants write a credit paper on a previously selected and approved topic area related to NGOs. Regardless of the chosen thematic area, the paper should address several issues: - It should refer to the given problem area in the context of the condition of NGOs in Poland and to the particular organizations we visited during the class. It should include in-depth descriptions of individual organizations from the perspective of the given thematic area and a comparison with other organizations and the condition of the third sector in Poland and the region in general.- References to studies from other countries are welcome, though not mandatory. - It should also take into account the dynamics of change in both micro (the organization in question), meso (local and regional level) and macro (country), as well as global perspectives. - It is to pay attention to the formal and informal spheres and the relationship between them, as well as the problems and difficulties of the organization. - It is also necessary to reflect critically on the functions, role and importance of the organization in the perspective of the subject area. Reference to research and analysis in the subject area will be evaluated, as well as the acquisition and presentation of information on the organizations in question. Also counted will be skillful reference to each level of analysis and reference to the literature assigned to these classes, including especially sociological theories and concepts.</p> | |
