Subject contents	Getting to know the specifics of the workshop of a teacher/special educator within the specialty in the institutions appropriate to it, getting to know the organizational principles of the institution, observation of students during various activities, observation and assistance during educational and therapeutic activities, learning about various forms and methods of work. Confronting the acquired psychological and pedagogical knowledge with pedagogical reality in practical action, and forming attitudes and personal qualities necessary for the work of a special educator. An important goal is the student's verification of his pedagogical-therapeutic interests and motivation to work with people with special educational needs. Acquisition, within a given specialty, of the skills to conduct classes appropriate to it. At least 60% of the total number of hours must be completed as an assistantship, which also includes independent instruction. The student should:- obtain information about the activities of the institution,- learn about the workshop of the teacher/therapist, and:- have the opportunity to confront the theoretical knowledge gained during the course of study with reality,- verify their pedagogical and therapeutic interests and motivation to work with people with special educational needs,- have the opportunity to test their own professional skills, as well as to realize creative ideas. The practice is also intended to shape attitudes and personal qualities necessary in a special educator.
