Subject contents	<p>Getting to know the specifics of the workshop of a teacher/special educator within the specialty in the institutions appropriate to it, getting to know the organizational principles of the institution, observation of students during various activities, observation and assistance during educational and therapeutic activities, learning about various forms and methods of work. Confronting the acquired psychological and pedagogical knowledge with the reality of pedagogical reality in practical action and the formation of attitudes and personal qualities necessary for the work of a special educator. An important goal is the student's verification of his pedagogical and therapeutic interests and motivation to work with people with special needs educational needs. Acquisition, within a given specialty, of the ability to conduct classes appropriate to it.
