W pierwszej części kursu zaprezentowane zostaną: metody i techniki badań psychologii religii, klasyczne koncepcje psychologiczne dotyczące psychicznych uwarunkowań religii (W. James, Z. Freud, K. G. Jung, E. Fromm, M. Erickson, V. Frankl) oraz charakterystyka psychologii religii jako dyscypliny naukowej. W drugiej części studenci zapoznają się z psychologicznym rozumieniem takich zjawisk i procesów jak: rozwój religijnego myślenia a ogólny psychiczny rozwój człowieka, neurobiologiczne podstawy doświadczenia religijnego, konwersja religijna, duchowość jako koncepcja psychologiczna, duchowość człowieka i jej rozwój, religia w procesie radzenia sobie z trudnymi sytuacjami życiowymi (religious coping).
