Exercises take the form of workshops with source texts (chronicles, hagiographical texts, documents, national law scrolls). Their aim is to develop the habit of critical evaluation of information contained in source texts by confronting various source accounts, different positions of researchers and forming an independent opinion on important political, economic, cultural and social issues.
