Probation measures. Failure to punish the perpetrator. Judicial punishment. Change of sentence imposed. Security measures. Abolition, amnesty, pardon. Statute of limitations. Expungement of conviction. Liability of minors and collective entities for prohibited acts. Issues of selected crimes and offenses. Rules of procedure in petty offence cases, procedures, rights and obligations of the parties.
