Subject contents	Exercises in translating texts from press services, selected by the instructor each time to suit the students' needs and their language skills. The materials come from press services such as pap.pl, dw.com, the press service of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland, the European Parliament, the European Commission, etc. The materials are downloaded from professional websites, which ensures a high substantive level as well as modernity and up-to-dateness of the texts. Current texts on socio-economic, cultural, health and environmental topics will be analyzed and translated. The classes include discussing the specificity of texts published in press services, terminology discussions, independent translation of texts by students, discussion of translations and possible differences in translations and terminology.
