To give a detailed presentation of the issues mentioned in the programme content of the lecture. To make students aware of the importance of the links between man and the natural world - on the example of the nomenclature of herbs.

			The Student knows the basic concepts and uses the terminology of linguistic nomination in a precise and correct manner. Has basic knowledge of the specifics and principles of medicinal plant nomenclature and understands the need to use proper names. Understands the relationship between the linguistic nomination of herbs, which is the subject of interest of linguistics, and issues from the area of other humanities, as well as natural, agricultural and medical sciences. Is able, using a variety of sources, to acquire, select and analyse knowledge concerning plant names. Is aware of the importance of the links between humans and the natural world, which are reflected in botanical nomenclature. Being aware of his/her knowledge and skills, understands the need for further education and development of his/her own competences in the scope of the subject of the lecture. Subject contents	Herbs (herbaceous plants, medicinal plants) - characteristics, number of species, classifications. People and medicinal plants - herbalism and herbology through the ages. Concept and modes of linguistic nomination. Types of medicinal plant species names. Latin scientific nomenclature - characteristics, principles. Vernacular nomenclature: nomenclatural names, folk names, other names in national languages. Generic grammatical characteristics and spelling rules of different types of names. Word borrowings and calques in botanical nomenclature. Semantic motivation of medicinal plant species names - variety of naming motifs: features of plant structure; natural habitat; medicinal properties and medical use; biological features; alternative uses of plants; geographical origin; cultural and odantroponymic motivations; names associated with mythology; other motivations. The lecture is delivered using a multimedia presentation, including illustrations of herbs whose names are analysed and compared. It primarily covers issues in linguistics, but the lecturer draws on botany, horticulture (herbalism), herbal medicine, ethnography, pharmaceutical history and others to explain the semantic motivation of the names. Examples of medicinal plant species names are given with explanations in 3 languages: Latin (systematic names), Polish and - for comparison - Russian (selected names only).
