Subject contents	The lecture is devoted to the Gdańsk Shipyard and its unique cultural heritage. During the classes, students will learn about the tangible and intangible dimensions of the shipyard's heritage. Issues related to the architecture and urban planning of the industrial complex, the history of its various forms of protection, and the process of gentrification will be discussed. The shipyard's connections with the fine arts and their evolution over the decades will be discussed. A separate topic is the shipyard as the centre of artistic life in the Tri-City, as well as exhibitions dedicated to it.
