Subject objectives	The aim of the practical classes is to develop students practical skills in analysing, interpreting and applying national sports regulations through real and model legal scenarios. The classes are intended to enable students to work independently with the Act on Sport, the Act on Combating Doping in Sport and the Act on the Safety of Mass Events, as well as to compare these regulations with solutions in selected European states and the United States. A key component of the classes is the development of skills in qualifying factual situations, preparing basic documents, and solving typical legal problems arising in the activities of sports organisations and public authorities responsible for sports governance.
