Subject contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 Sources of information in economic analysis Discusses where to get data for business analysis (financial statements, public records, market data) and how to assess their reliability. 2. preliminary analysis of financial statements (balance sheet, income statement, cash flow) A structural and trend analysis of the main items of the financial statements is carried out in order to make an overall assessment of the company's financial position. 3. analysis of assets and capital (balance sheet). The structure of the company's assets and liabilities is examined, analyzing their dynamics, liquidity and debt levels. 4. analysis of income, expenses and financial results (income statement). Analyzes the profitability of a company by examining the relationship between revenues, operating expenses and financial results. 5. financial flow analysis (cash flow statement). Sources and uses of cash in operating, investing and financing activities are evaluated, as well as their impact on liquidity. 6. technical-economic analysis The efficiency of the use of physical resources and human labor (machinery, equipment, employees) is evaluated, analyzing their impact on costs, productivity and financial performance of the enterprise.
