Subject contents	As part of the seminar, students learn about the rights of volunteers and the available forms of voluntary activities, e.g. NGOs. The instructor prepares a list of about 5 (or less) selected institutions for the year, which will be invited to present their activities to the students in an online format. It is particularly desirable to invite several institutions working for German-Polish cooperation, e.g. Borussia, the House of History in Gliwice, the Foundation for European Understanding Krzyżowa, the Maximilian Kolbe House, but also the Herder Centre, the CBH of the Polish Academy of Sciences in Berlin and others. Students choose a possible form of activity which they will carry out in cooperation with these institutions, or propose others known from their surroundings. The instructor coordinates and supervises the development and planning of the project that the student will carry out as part of the field exercise.
