Subject contents	The Master's Seminar in Religious Studies (4 semesters) is one of the most important courses of the second degree program, in which the student conducts his own research work on a selected topic, carried out under the supervision of a supervisor. During the seminar, the student acquires and develops skills appropriate to his or her research interests. The seminar leads to the writing of a master's thesis on a topic chosen by the student and its defense, corresponding to the problems of the specialty he or she has studied so far as a leading one. The approaches used to write the thesis are formulated and agreed upon with the thesis supervisor.
