Students will acquire advanced knowledge and skills necessary to conduct research in the above-mentioned area under the supervision of a thesis advisorranging from identifying a research problem to developing a literature review and writing the first chapter of the thesis using appropriate academic terminology. In the case of a bachelors project: students will acquire advanced knowledge and skills necessary to formulate project assumptions. The seminar also focuses on developing skills in publicly presenting ones own theses and engaging in critical discussion.

There is also the possibility of preparing and in some cases implementing a project in the field of cultural activities, resulting in a diploma thesis in the form of a report. • Introduction to the specifics of research within the discipline addressed by the seminar. • Introduction to research ethics. • Selection of a thesis topic and formulation of a specific research problem, or development of project assumptions. • Definition of the research methodology: methods of data collection and analysis techniques. • Preparation of a first draft of the literature review, research questionnaire (if applicable), and a chapter of the thesis. • For project-based theses: preparation of an implementation budget, identification of potential funding sources, and establishment of cooperation with partner institutions. • Presentation of the literature review and preliminary concepts for the thesis or bachelors project.
