It is possible to divide the internship time into two places (e.g. 45 hours in each of two selected places), on two different dates during two years of studies. At least three weeks before the start of the internship, it is necessary to complete the formalities - details on the website of the Department of Cultural Studies in the "Regulations of student professional internships - Cultural Studies" tab in the "Information for students" tab after selecting the "Practices" tab - Student professional internships in the Cultural Studies program (https://fil.ug.edu.pl/wydzial_filologiczny/institute_i_katedry/zaklad_kulturoznawstwa/informacje_dla_studentow/praktyki)
