

**Regulation No. 39/ R/20  
of the Rector of the University of Gdańsk  
of 9 April 2020**

**amending the regulation of the Rector of the University of Gdańsk 24/R/20 on  
managing teaching, academic and research activity at the University of Gdańsk at  
the time of emergency due to the risk of SARS-Cov-2 coronavirus transmission**

under article 23 section 2 item 2, article 50 section 1 and article 51 section 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science law (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85 as amended) in connection with the Act of 2 March 2020 on emergency solutions related to preventing, counteracting and eradicating COVID-19 as well as other contagious diseases and resulting crises (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 374) and in compliance with the recommendations of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education - the following is ordered:

§ 1.

Regulation No. 24/R/20 of the Rector of the University of Gdańsk of 12 March 2020 on managing teaching, academic and research activity at the University of Gdańsk at the time of emergency due to the risk of SARS-Cov-2 coronavirus transmission is amended as follows:

1) § 1 shall be replaced by the following:

„§ 1.

1. Subject to paragraph 2, during the period of suspension of classes specified in separate provisions, research and academic employees are required to conduct all classes within the BA, MA programmes, including the uniform MA programmes, as well as post-graduate programmes via e-learning/on-line teaching tools - regardless of whether this form of classes was previously included in the study program.
2. The dean, director of the Center or head of postgraduate studies may decide not to conduct the classes referred to in paragraph 1 in the form of distance teaching if the form of these classes or learning outcomes prevent it.
3. The classes referred to in paragraph 2, will re-start immediately after the restoration of teaching activity at the University of Gdańsk within the extended period of conducting classes in the summer semester.
4. In the case of classes conducted in the distance teaching form, the dean's office or the secretary's office of a general university unit:
  - 1) keeps records of classes;
  - 2) verifies the participation of students in classes.";

2) § 5 shall be replaced by the following:

„§ 5. Records of classes referred to in § 1 section 4 and other documentation of conducted e-learning or on-line classes should be submitted to the Education Section (Dział Kształcenia) immediately after the suspension period.”.

§ 2.

The ordinance enters into force on the day of signing and is valid until further notice.
