UG VISITING PROFESSORS

Internationalisation of HEIs is the process of integrating the international, intercultural and global dimension into research and academic education. To meet these needs, as part of the Excellence Initiative "University Research at the University of Gdańsk" programme, the UG Visiting Professors Program was established to finance medium (5-12 weeks) and short-term (2-4 weeks) visits by outstanding scientists from abroad.

"The competition for visiting professors is an element of building an academic environment based on openness and cultural sensitivity and developing multi-level relations with foreign universities. The presence of inspiring scientists from abroad mobilises the improvement of scientific research and the exchange of research experience, while for students it provides a unique opportunity to establish international contacts." -said Professor Anna Maria Jurkowska-Zeidler, Vice-Rector for International Cooperation. In the first edition of the program, the Validation Committee selected 8 out of 14 applications. The laureates included candidates from the Faculty of Philology, Faculty of Oceanography and Geography, Faculty of Social Sciences and Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Computer Science. The group of selected 'visiting professors' included researchers from Hungary, Israel, Slovenia, Singapore, France, Italy, Slovakia and Germany.

The second call, which started on 17 January will end on 28 February. The results of the second round of 'UG Visiting Professors' will be announced by 14 March.

NEW COOPERATION AGREEMENTS SIGNED

In December 2021 the University of Gdańsk signed five new cooperation agreements. The Faculty of Social Sciences initiated cooperation with University Padjadjaran (Indonesia), Khmelnytskyi National University (Ukraine) and Ternopil Volodymyr Hnatiuk National Pedagogical University (Ukraine). The Faculty of Management started cooperation with Business Academy Aarhus (Denmark) and the Faculty of Law and Administration initiated cooperation with Mutah University (Jordan).

ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS



The recruitment for the Erasmus+ summer semester 2021/2022 at the University of Gdańsk has concluded demonstrating impressive results.

Under the KA131 mobilities (EU + Turkey) our university has accepted a total of 112 students from as many as 13 countries - Austria, Germany, Portugal, Spain, France, Greece, Croatia, Italy, Malta, Romania, Turkey, Czech Republic, and the Netherlands, including all our SEA-EU alliance partners.

Under the KA107 mobilities (non-EU) our institution was delighted to cooperate with partner countries Kenia and Israel.

Even though the COVID-19 outbreak posed an unprecedented challenge for any higher education institution, ensuring the delivery of key aspects of the Programme is always a priority.

At the same time, the University of Gdańsk has embraced the new challenges arising from the pandemic, being at the forefront of digital transformation and mitigating the impact of the pandemic on our student community, which was hit extremely hard. Our institution remained true to its academic commitments and supported flexible, hybrid and online modes of learning at all times.

These efforts will continue to ensure that our partnerships remain productive and successful.

4TH EDITION OF THE BEKKER NAWA PROGRAMME. LAUREATES FROM UG

Dr Anna Malankowska from the Faculty of Chemistry (Department of Environmental Technology), dr Paweł Mazierski from the Faculty of Chemistry (Department of Environmental Technology) and dr Maurycy Żarczyński from the Faculty of Oceanography and Geography (Institute of Geography) of the University of Gdańsk are among the winners of this year's edition of the Bekker NAWA scholarship programme, one of the flagship programmes of the National Agency for Academic Exchange. It's aim is to support the international mobility of PhD students, scientists and academic teachers in pursuit of scientific excellence by giving them the opportunity to conduct research at renowned foreign institutions around the world.

Each of the winners will go on a research internship to a prestigious foreign scientific centre.

Dr Anna Malankowska will spend her three-month internship at the University of Nova Gorica (Slovenia) carrying out her project "Covalent organic backbone composites / Cu NPs for CO2 conversion". Dr Paweł Mazierski will go to the Columbia University in New York for a yearlong internship, where he will carry our his research on 'Bifunctional organometallic frameworks based on cerium for the selective photoconversion of biomass and CO2 into high-value chemicals and fuels'.

And then, Dr Maurycy Żarczyński during his internship scheduled for a year and a half, will carry out a project "Reconstruction of environmental changes during the glacial-interglacial cycle in the last 1.3 million years, recorded in the sediments of Lake Stoneman (Arizona, USA): a novel approach using imaging".

The internship will take place at Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff (USA). We congratulate the winners and wish them continued scientific success!


